- 1. **Policy:** It is the policy of Communities Connected for Kids to provide various simple mechanisms to facilitate the needs of clients, foster parents, parents or employees who may be in receipt of in-kind gifts. Examples of these types of gifts are holiday toys, school supplies and clothing. An acceptable mechanism is the collection drive.
- **2. Purpose:** To provide needed assistance to children and families served by the Communities Connected for Kids child-welfare system of care.
- **3. Scope:** This operating procedure describes the procedures for collecting and distributing inkind gifts to employees, providers, and clients of Communities Connected for Kids.
- 4. Procedures:

Accountability and Tracking

- a. All in-kind gifts will be recorded in the approved data-collection system. This registry will include at minimum:
 - 1) Description
 - 2) Estimated value
 - 3) Date of donation
 - 4) Any specified use
 - 5) Notice of acknowledgment, gratitude, receipt or tax exemption
- b. This registry will be maintained by the Community Relations Department.

Inventory Control

- 1) The record will be updated regularly and available for auditing.
- 2) Community Relations will be responsible for maintaining a master log of all gifts.
- 5. Dissemination: A copy of this plan will be kept in the administrative share drive.
- 6. Revision: This plan will be updated as needed but at least annually.
